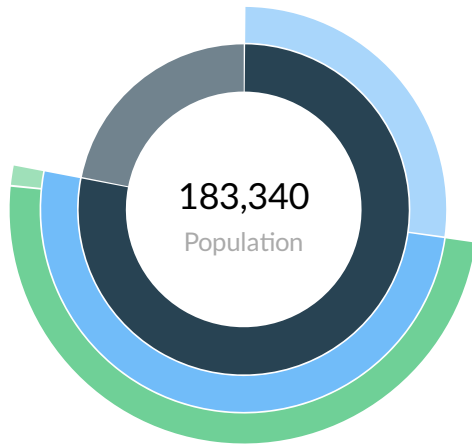

- Concerning educational attainment, **14.8% of Ellis County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (4.0% below the national average), and **8.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.1% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2019 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Plastics Product Manufacturing.

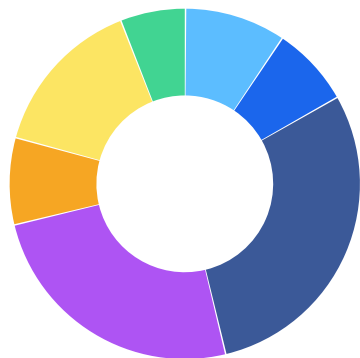

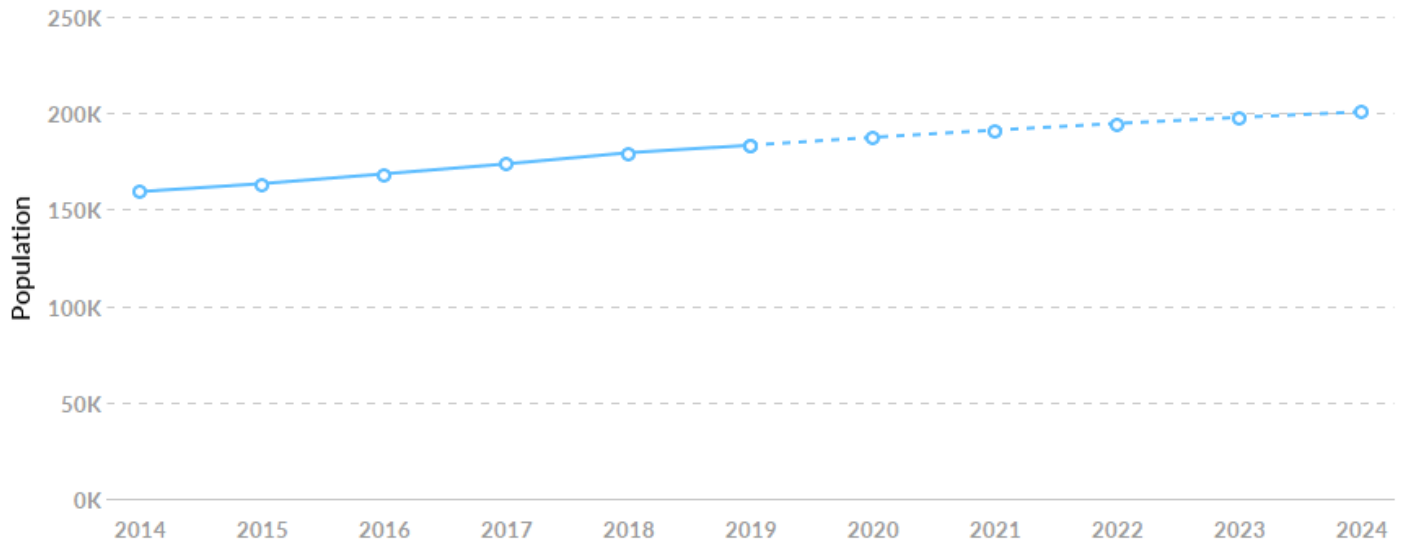

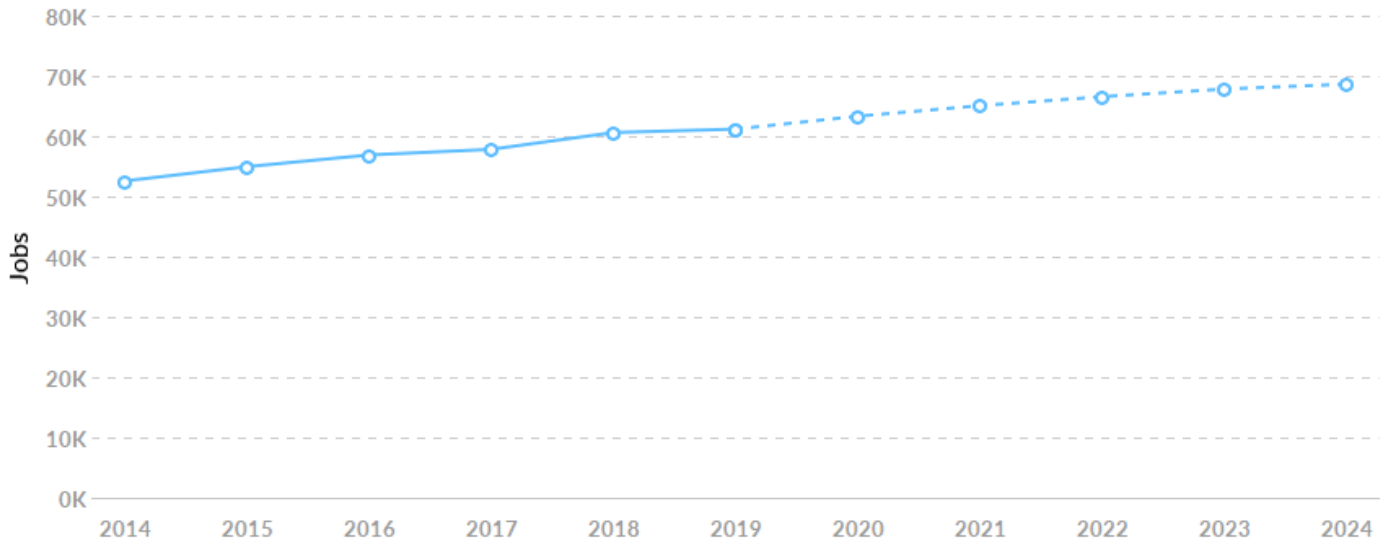

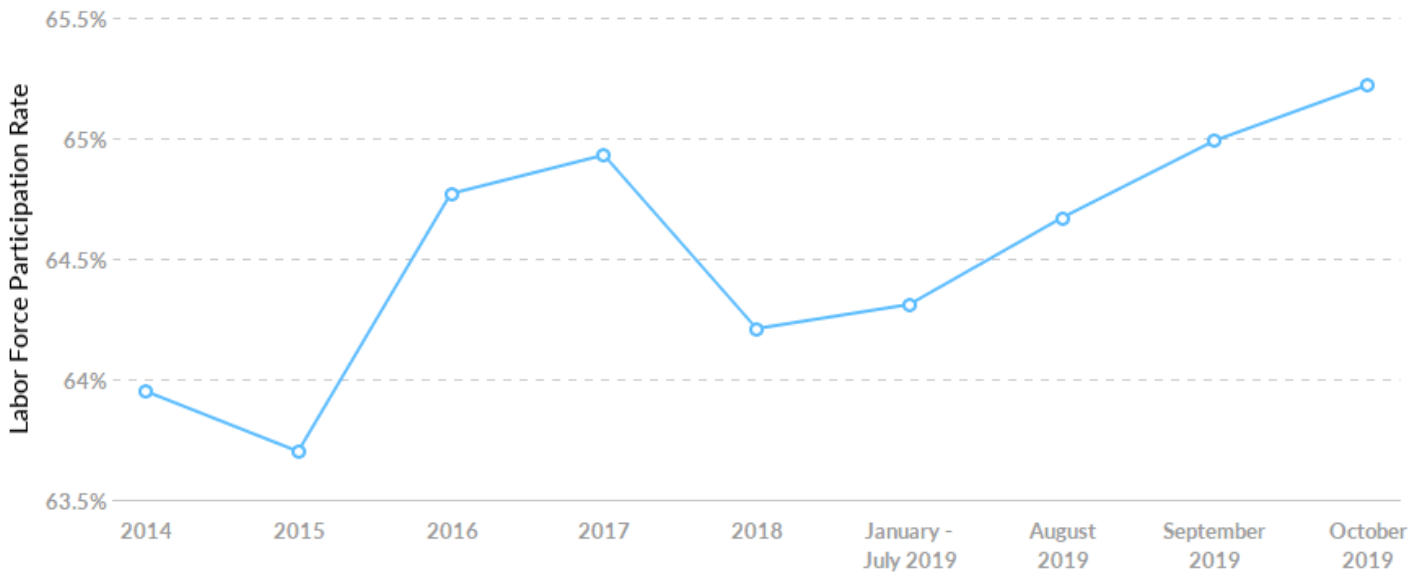
Job Trends

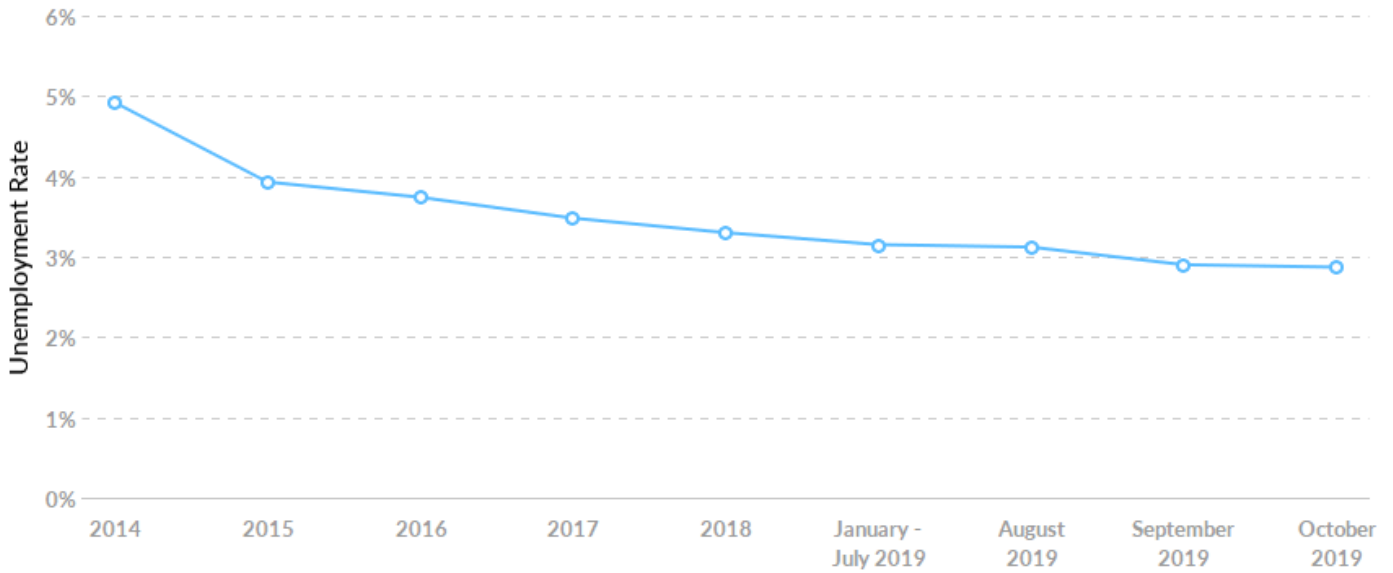

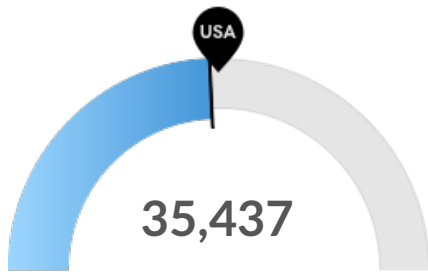
Unemployment Rate Trends

Ellis County, TX had an October 2019 unemployment rate of 2.87%, **decreasing from 4.92%** 5 years before.



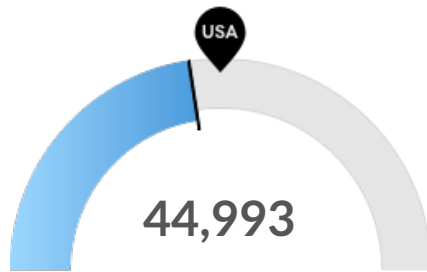

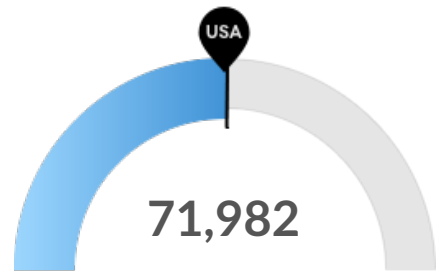
Millennials

Ellis County, TX has 35,437 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 36,890.



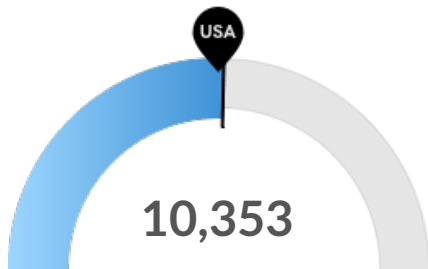
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in Ellis County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 51,941 people 55 or older, while there are 44,993 here.



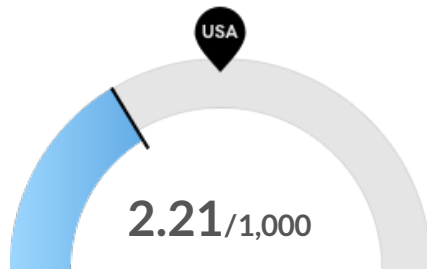
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is about average in Ellis County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 71,091 racially diverse people, while there are 71,982 here.



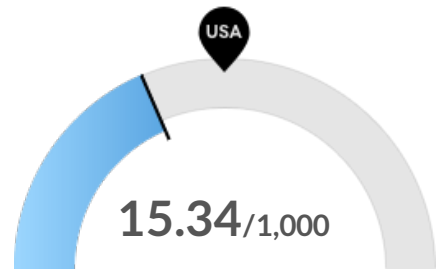
Veterans

Ellis County, TX has 2.21 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.87 per 1,000 people.

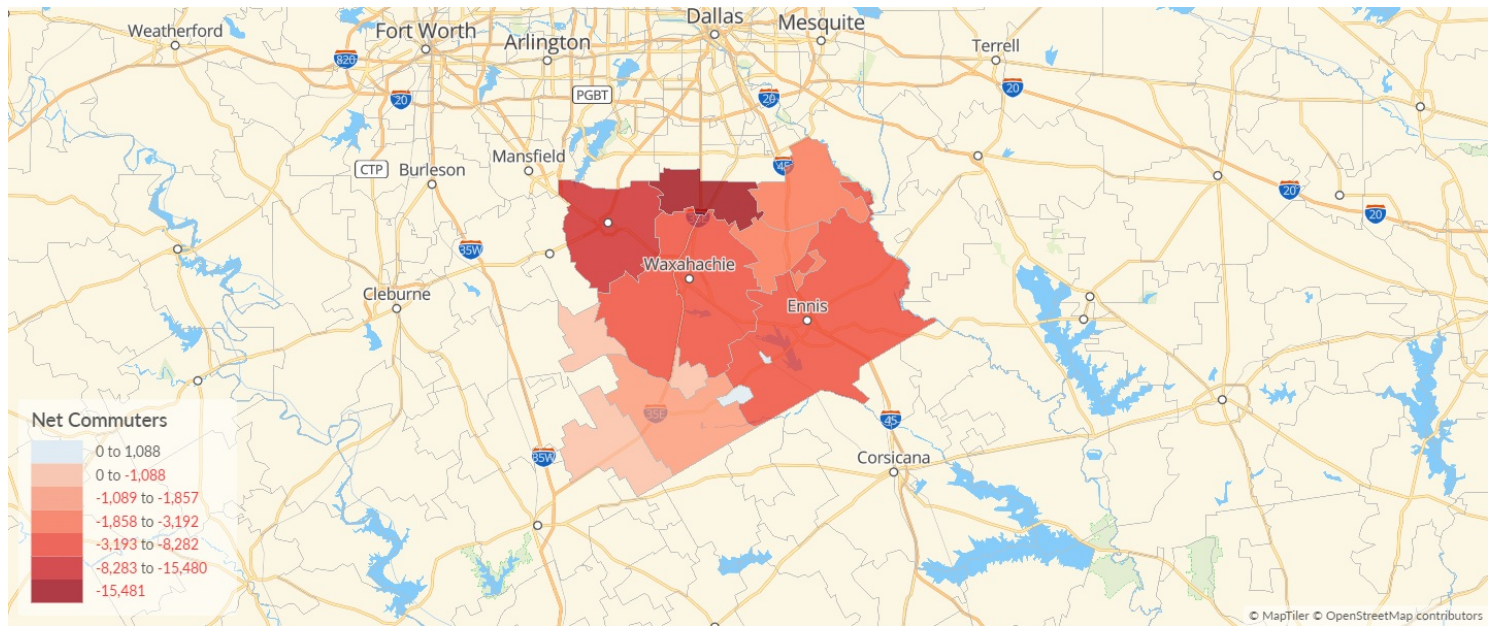


Property Crime

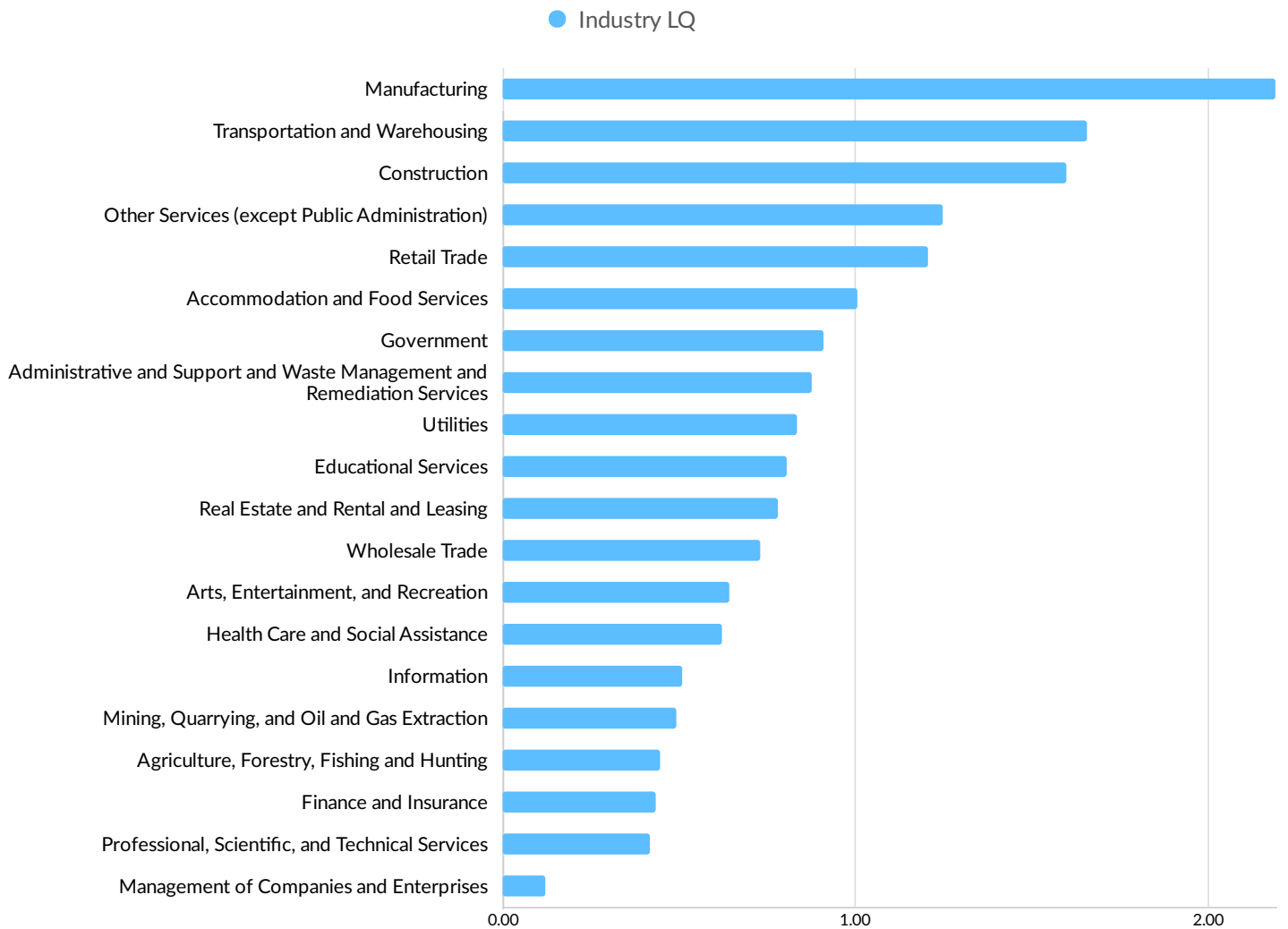

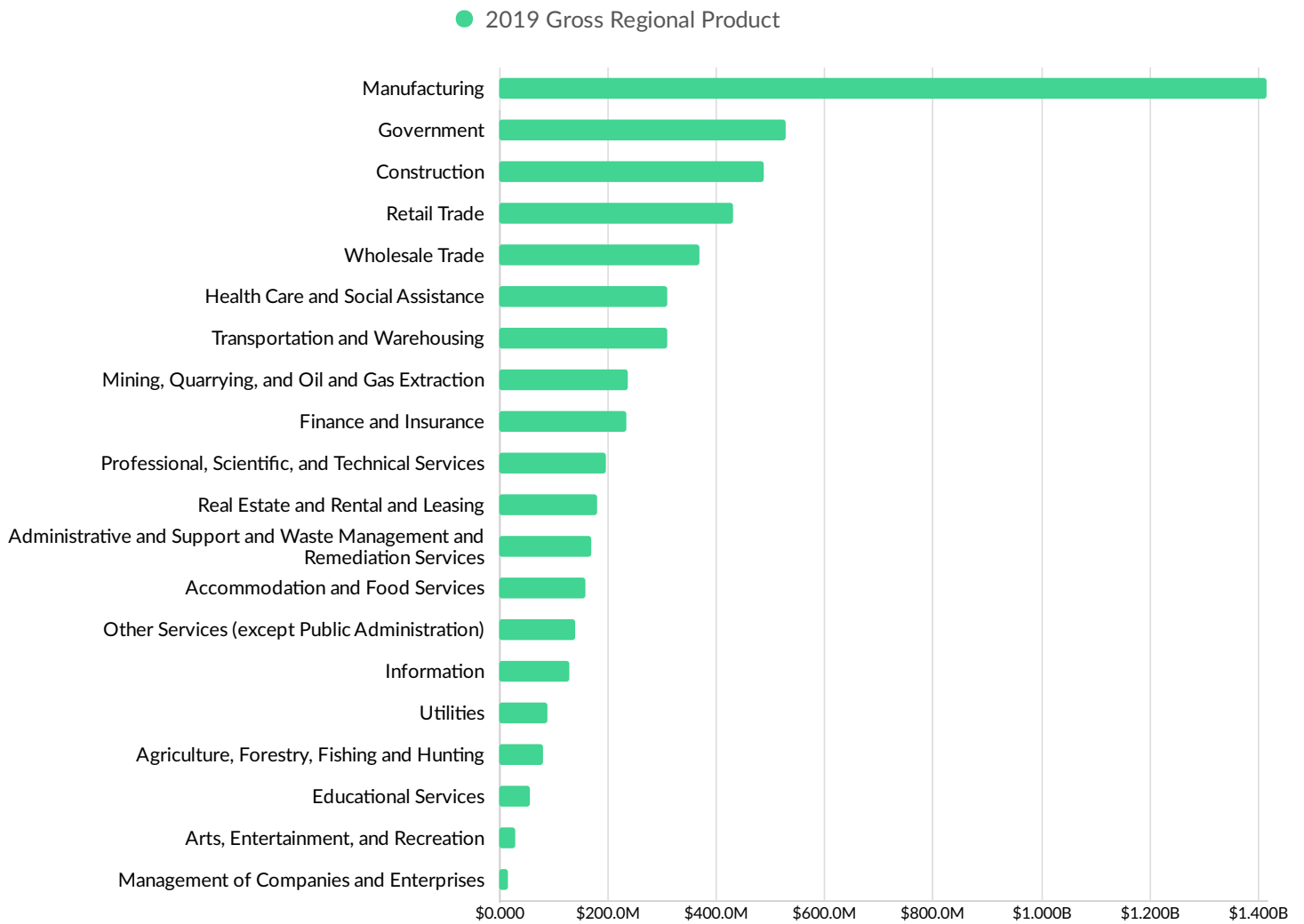

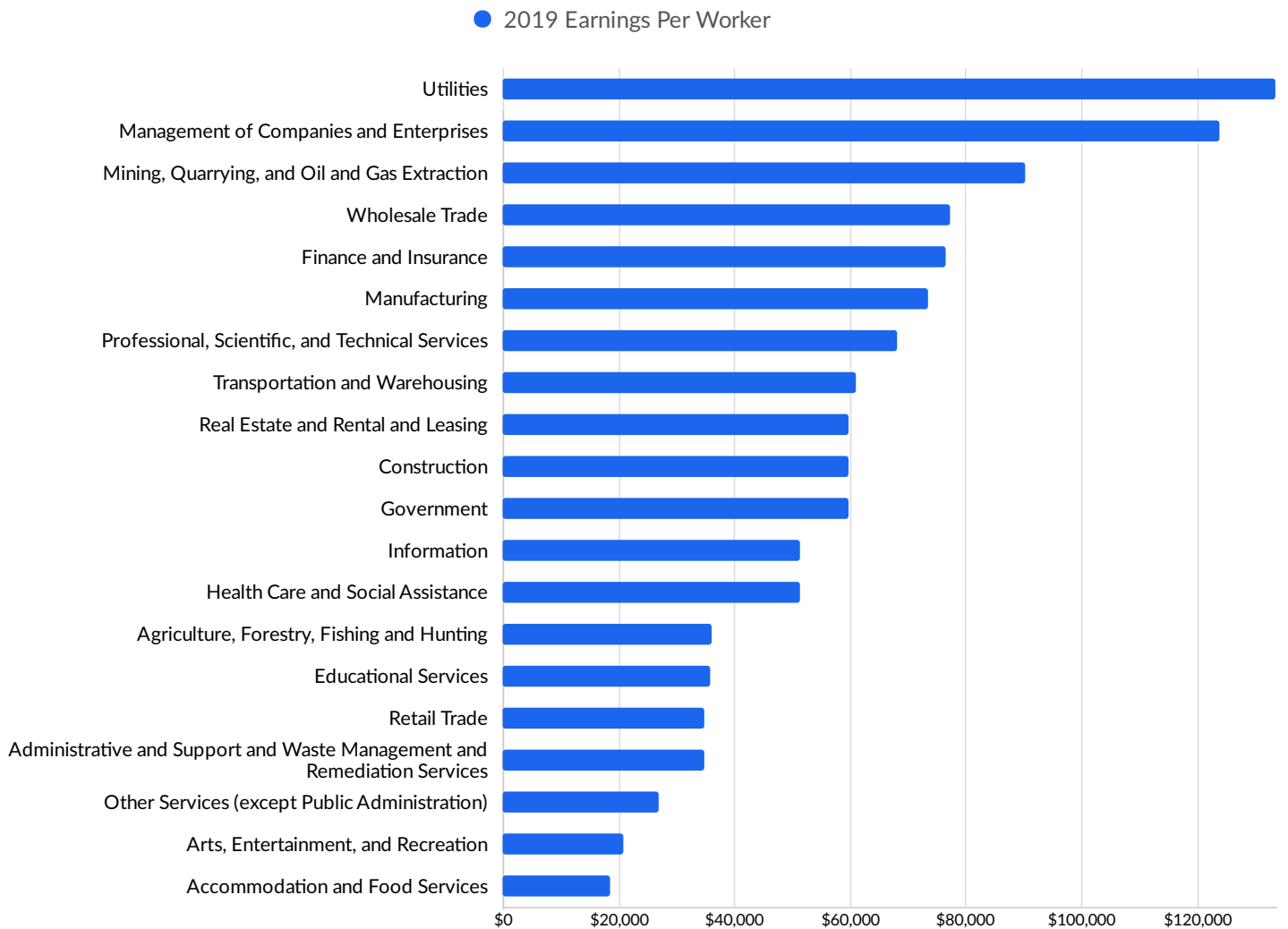

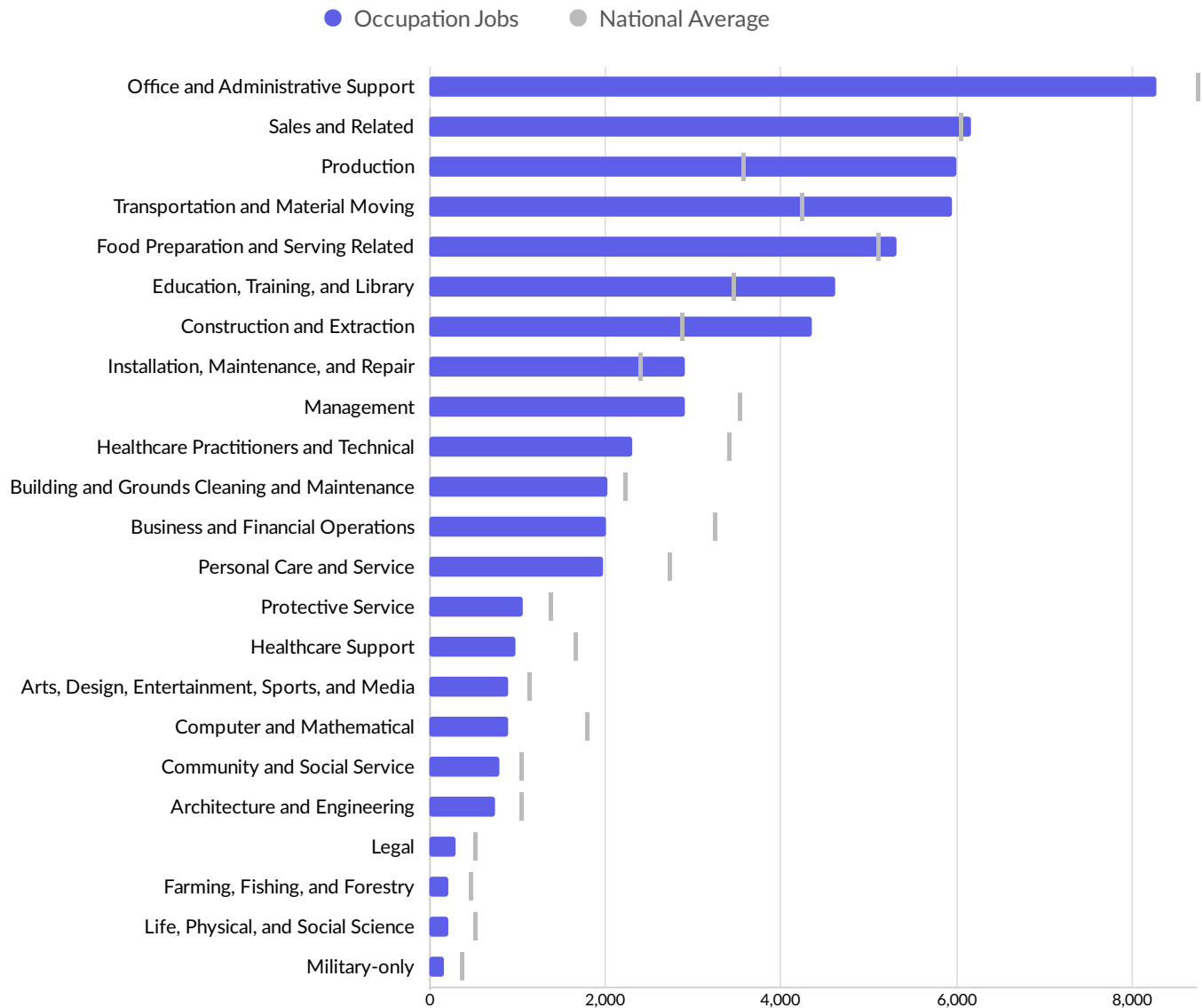

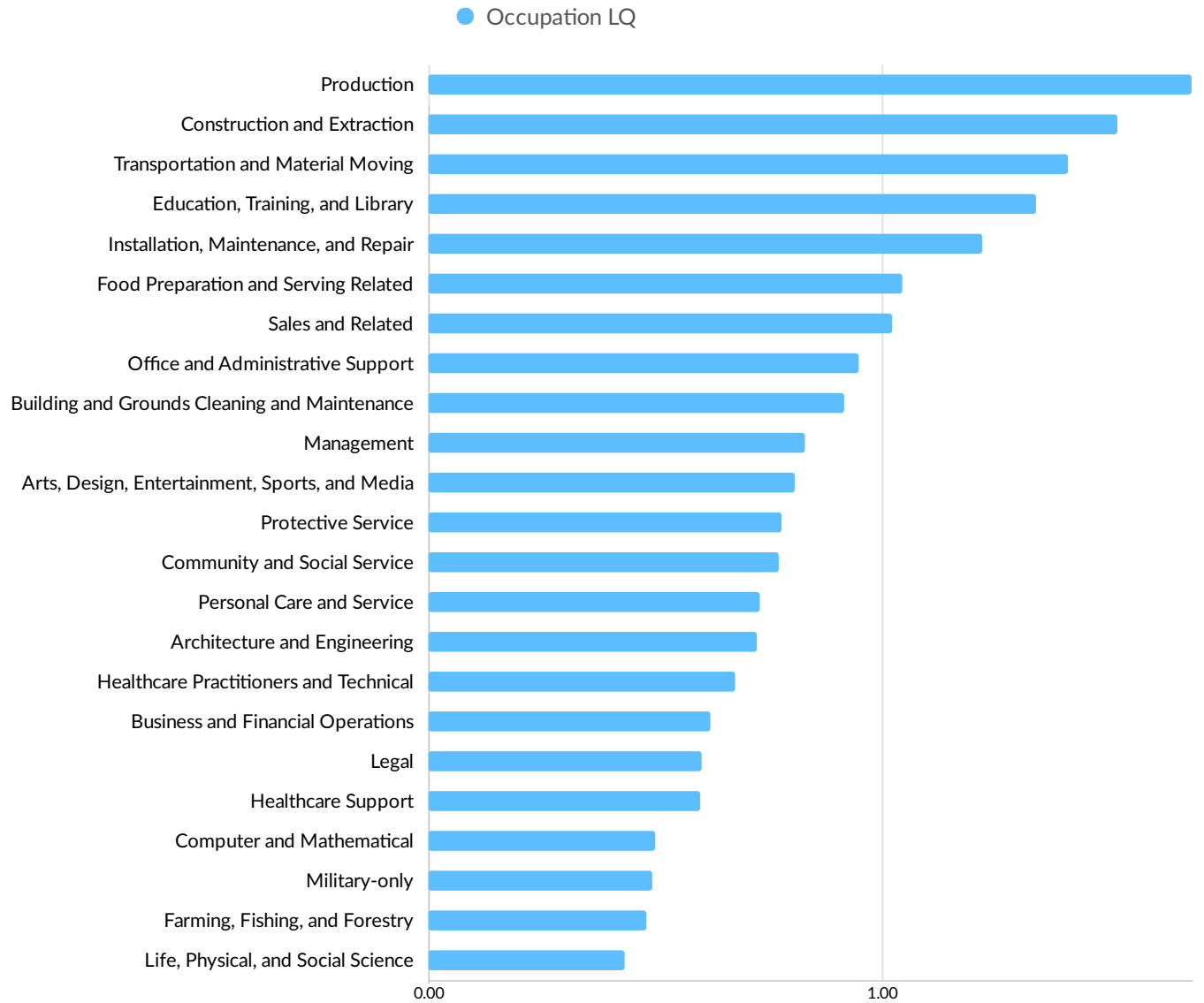

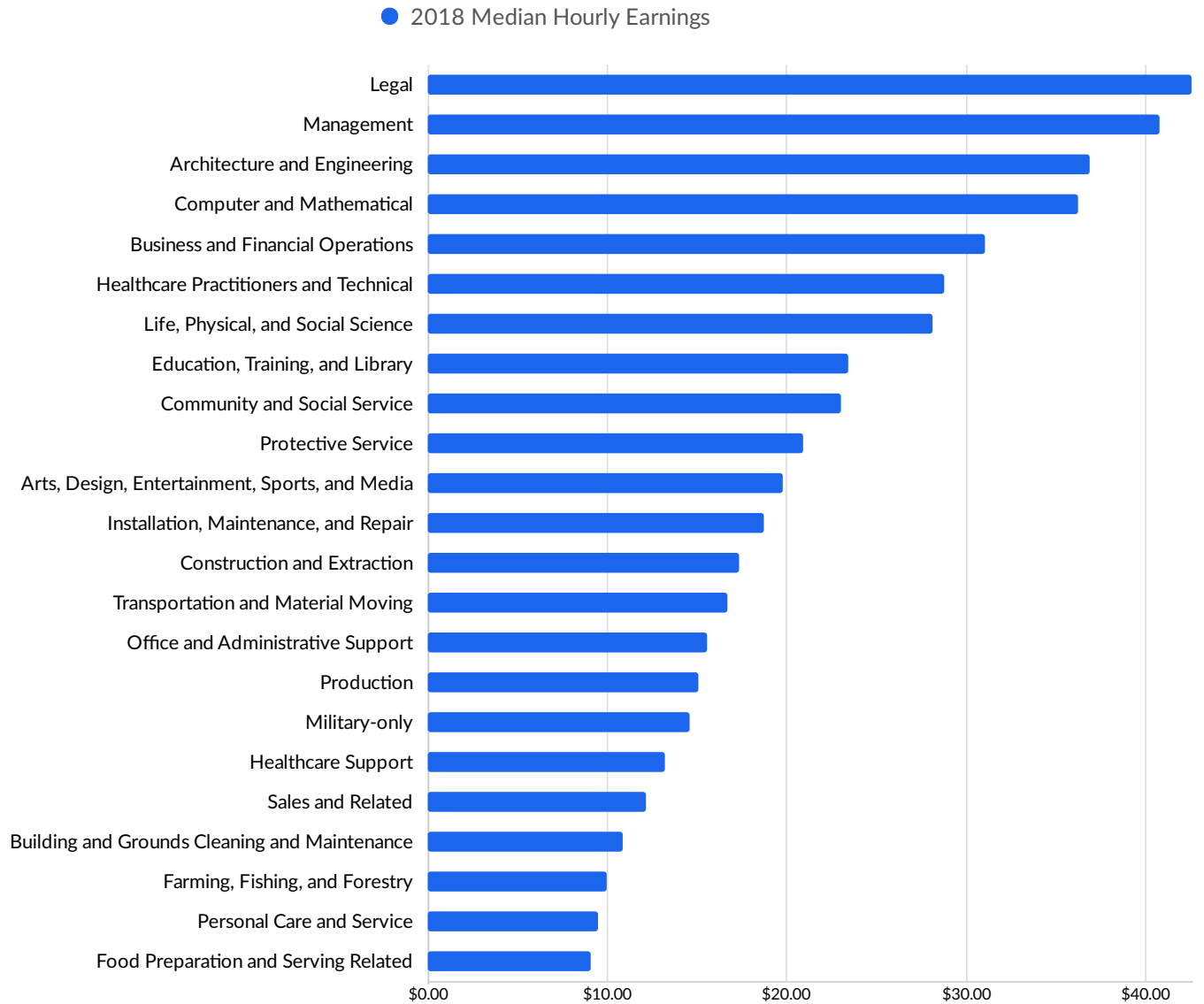

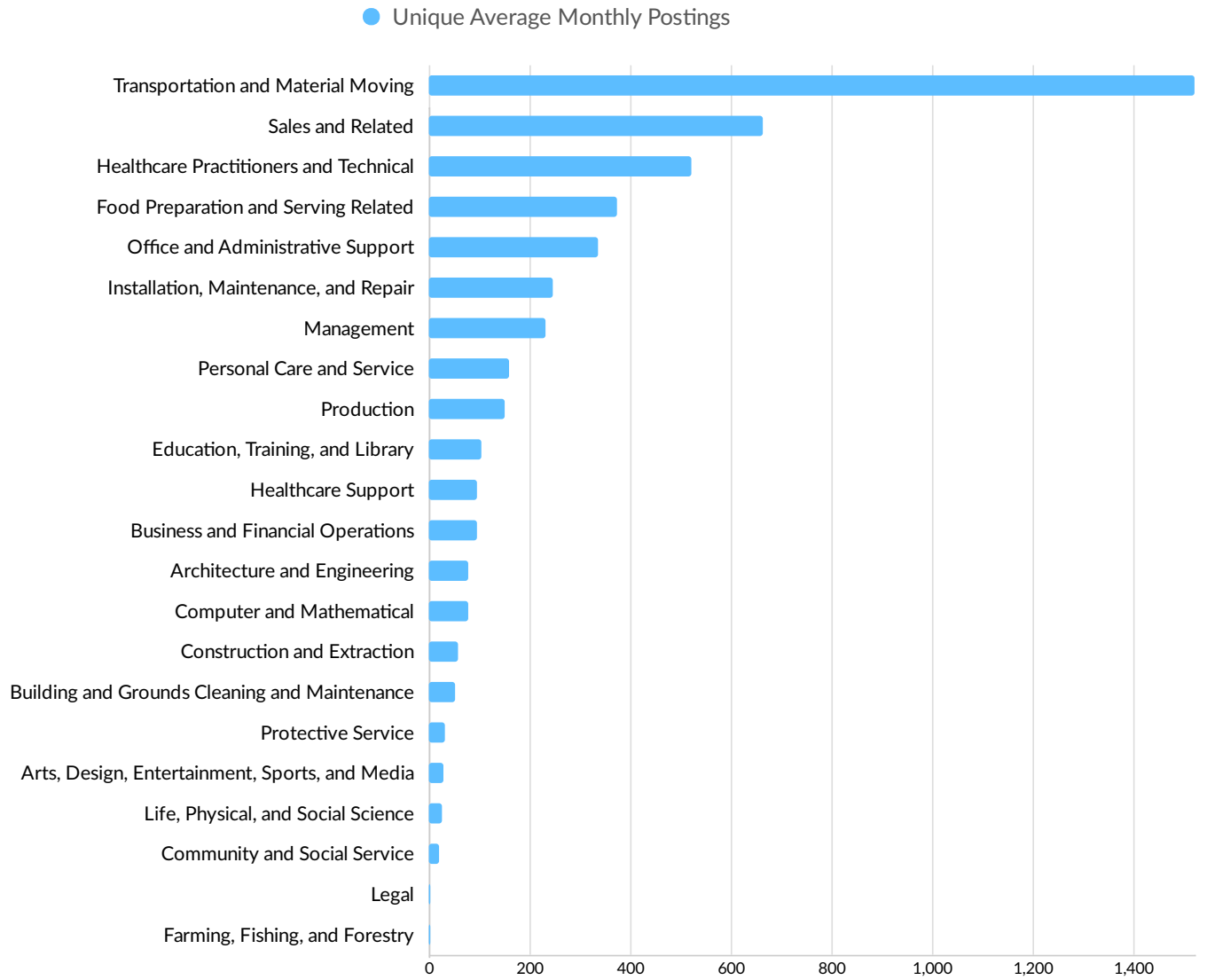

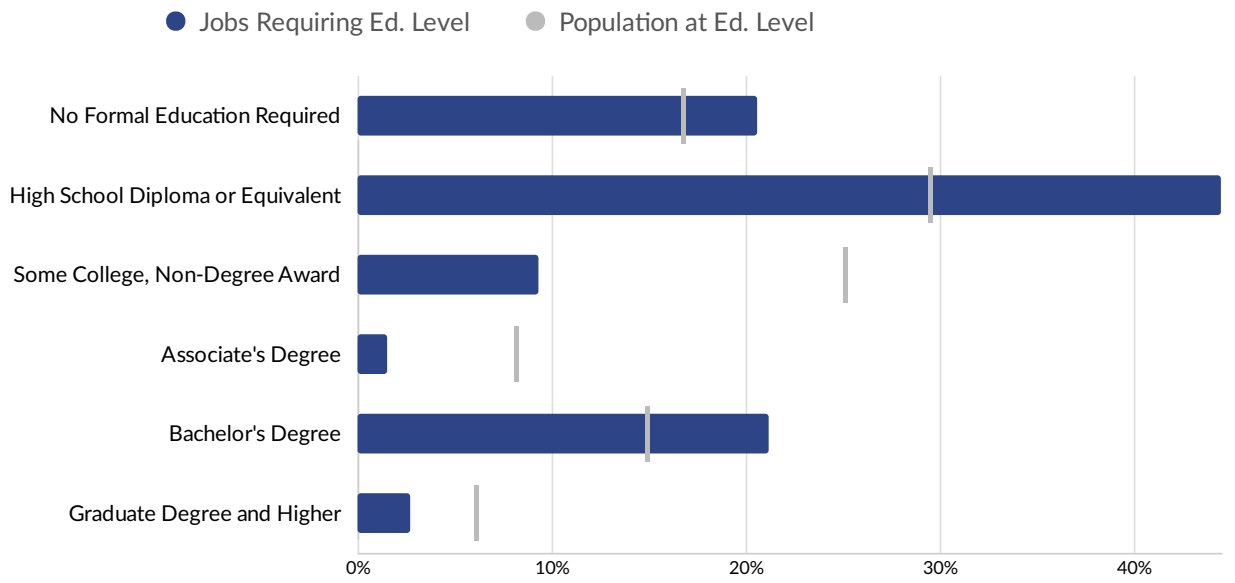
