STRATEGIC PLANNING WORKSHOP – Council will deliberate and workshop Long Range Planning.


BUDGET WORKSHOP: The City Manager will make a general presentation and overview of the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Annual Operating Budget on the following topics:

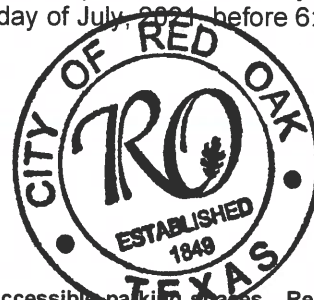
1. **BUDGET SUMMARY** and overview of the entire budget.
